Planning of the seminar started in Vienna at our last GA together with SG Frerik Kampman and AYUFD IO Farah Irgsousi.

The title of the seminar was 'Towards a Common freedom and human rights vision for the Arab world' and we worked on establishing the event's goals, formulating the program was a bit hard as we had to change it a lot until it suits all the partners .

IFLRY appointed a full facilitation team I was one of them , I was a bit relaxed as I have full trust from the participants in term of the language and understanding the habits and the way of thinking and working and so I used that to implement the non-formal education way that we use in iflry, in fact it was a success. Besides helping other facilitators in the logistics stuff, I was responsible of an important and very critical session, "Liberalism vs Political Islam" the point was to see what are the challenges that the arab liberals face especially with the huge spreading of the political islam the session went very good it was more a small introduction an interactive video that led to an interesting discussion then group work and we ended up with a small booklet about the challenges and how we can face it. After seminar a general assembly of AYUFD started our presence was for a certain time explaining the role of ayufd as a regional member in IFLRY and talked a bit about iflry and how can ayufd benefits from its presence in our international organization and the support that we provide, and a brief of our work, manifesto and annual plan of action, the crowed were very interested as the meeting afterwards was about their statutes a lot of questions were posed. Unfortunately the term of the Gender Equality program Manager Alena Santalainen has ended, and it's an opportunity to thank her on the great job that she did and for the time and efforts that she spent.
