Climate Change Programme

Led by and in partnership with Tone Bjorndal, we have created one of the most effective programs run by IFLRY. Building upon our climate change themed GA conference in Vienna, the Programme has finalized IFLRY's position paper on environmental policy – the first such policy document IFLRY has produced in years. This after consultation with the Programme Team, the executive, and our Member Organizations around the world. Leading up to the Climate Change Conference in Paris, France, we once again have a diverse and accomplished group 8+ young liberals from around the world ready to participate for two weeks in December. And again, this will be one of the largest delegations IFLRY has sent in years.

Belarus and Ukraine Programme

Led by and in partnership with Treasure Daniel George, we continue to secure funds from IDI, VVD, and other international initiatives for one of our most active programs. In that sense our agenda for 2016 is secure with events in Ukraine, Lithuania, and Poland planned accounted for.

We have one event left for 2015 focused on internet security. And particularly given the Liberal victory in Canada, we are assured of financial support for F2016 from the Embassy of Canada.
