

Resolution 2: Stop outsourcing refugees to Turkey

Acknowledging that:

- the root of the problems, the wars and unstable situations is not looking to get better. Due to the ongoing charge on Mosul the amount of refugees from Syria will increase in the neighbouring countries

-the humanitarian situation for the 3 million refugees in Turkey is not improving -the deal agreed upon with Turkey sharply reduce the number of refugees going to Europe -the deal agreed upon on with Turkey implicates increased number of refugees in already crowded neighbouring countries in the Middle East

-there's an opportunity for Europe to take a greater responsibility in the ongoing refugee crisis

We call upon:

- IFLRY member organizations to urge their governments to take responsibility in accepting refugees.

-IFLRY member organizations to urge their governments and/or mother parties to raise their financial support to UNHCR if possible.

-IFLRY member organizations to urge their governments and/or mother parties to work together to form a more sustainable and equal plan for the ongoing refugee crisis

- IFLRY to work toward a policy replacing the current EU-Turkey deal with a international refugee plan
