Over five years since the Arab Spring started, IFLRY wants to join its member organizations and partners in the MENA region for its final Executive Committee. Besides addressing organizational issues, the gathering will focus on entrepreneurship and economic self-determination. Around 100 young liberals from all over the world will gather in Amman, Jordan to discuss solutions to the high level of youth unemployment, social innovation, starting a business and (economic) autonomy.

Outcomes for Conference & EC:

- Interaction between liberal youth activists, entrepreneurs 'on the ground' and (high-level) policy makers on the subject 'youth entrepreneurship & economic self-determination'
- MENA partners & interaction with other organisations: entrepreneurship & economic self-determination bringing local perspectives;
- Best-practice sharing on employment policies, migration, and pushing for a global liberal agenda for IFLRY and its MOs to (further) execute;
- Strengthening IFLRY's role within the organisations (ambassadors)
- Living up to expectations on organising statutory event:
 - Confirm statutory changes as proposed in Istanbul + discuss statutory changes on membership
 - Final Executive Committee if statutory changes are approved
 - Success:
 - Number of MOs in total: 30
 - Europe:
 - MENA: 6
 - North America: 2South America: 2
 - Asia: 2
 - Sub-Saharan Africa: 2
 - New MO applications: 5 [possibly: Venezuela, Senegal, Mexicans, Philippines; observers: Denmark, Jordan, Dominican Republic]
 - Number of participants: 80 (for reference: 25 at EC Santo Domingo, 100 at GA in Istanbul)
 - 2 high-level speakers: Erik Ullenhag & ?
