Free Egyptian party report year 2015-2016

1st : Campaigns

1. Against extremism Campaign (April-July 2015)

this campaign aims to spread the awareness among the citizens of the danger of extremism , develop analysis for causes of extremism specially religious extremism and develop policy packages based on the analysis , a nationwide survey around the causes and means of solving this problem were done . a narrative report had been presented to FEP specialized committees and with participation of Free Egyptians Youth (FEY) developed policies on education & poverty elevation that was included to FEP electoral program , also FEY in association with underground theater companies sponsored a play under the name of " peanut " to introduce the risks of extremism adding to that training huge numbers of volunteers for this campaign.

Essay Contest "pens against extremism .. youth writings " was part of the campaign aimed to helping young people to write about the seriousness of the reasons for extremism and ways to treat it .

2. why you should vote for partisan candidate not a non-affiliated one : (August – September 2015)

Phase one of 2 phases campaign aimed to educate & raise awareness of citizens engagement in the electoral process & about the importance of political parties, and reasons to vote for partisan candidate, the campaign featured the benefits of electing the party candidate, phase one was very successful that many of other political parties candidates used it's materials with mentioning to FEY.

3. why you should vote for FEP candidate (September – November 2015 :

As phase 2 of the campaign educating & raising awareness of citizens engagements in the electoral process , this phase was focused on promoting FEP candidates , platform and electoral activities included workshops, focus groups , social media, public meetings and fliers distribution

4. Be "Basiouny" & Don't Be " El-Bala'asy" (Ongoin)

The aim of this campaign is to promote values of liberalism & FEP policies amongst young people , through 2 cartoon characters a liberal cool young guy called "Basiouny "(which very rare name for young guy to be named and yet funny , and the opposite a traditional populist conservative middle aged man called " EL balaasy" which is a rare yet funny name .many daily issues , hot topics, and controversial policies have been discussed and explained by the 2 characters.

The activities for the campaign are focus groups, workshops & social media

5. Evil people "Ahl El Shar" campaign (ongoing) :

A social media campaign to shed light on the horrible deeds & actions of some leaders and their crimes against their own people and the right of humanity (Hassan Nasrallah, Saddam Hussein, Sayed Qutb, Hassan al-Banna, Guevara, , Stalin, Mao) goal of the campaign to reflect on the historical deeds and to give a clear warning of the illiberal propaganda and how it led nations into misery and

2nd: simulation models (ongoing):

A nationwide series of capacity building activities aims to offer education & hands-on experience for youth. In these activities we explain the frame work , history , scoop of these institutions , and how to put the draft law, and specific of drafting policies till passing it into a legislation. Over the past year we had executed several models like American Congress", "House of Commons", and the Egyptian Parliament," and UN Security Council

3rd Debate club (ongoing):

FEY was the first youth organization to bring the debate clubs to the Egyptian political sphere, we noticed the lack of dialogue and debate the different ideas in the political culture of Egypt, therefore we started this activity to teach young people the importance of dialogue in the changing society and the development of the power of persuasion and knowledge of issues affecting our society to become an influential person and more capable politician, the other purpose of the club was to raise awareness of liberal policies and promote it among public audience , the club currently operates in 8 local branches all over Egypt. With plans to cover the entire nation by mid-2017.

4th .Networking & cooperation:

1.Local Joint Activities

FEY have participated in several joint activities on local level with other political parties.

Starting from feb.2016 FEY is leading the efforts of coordination and dialogue between Youth organizations in the Egyptian political parties from the entire political spectrum , this led to success of Min. of Youth national dialogue between Egyptian political parties to agree on national youth agenda.

Moreover FEY led coordination between Youth organizations and actively participated in the National Youth Conference in October 2016, FEY members were panelists and speakers in the majority of conference session.

FEY led the efforts after the conference to capitalize on its success and led the initiative to develop a dialogue with the presidential office based on 3 policies developed jointly to cover combating illiteracy , enhancing volunteerism & establish national council for volunteering .

In summer 2016 FEY participated in the Egyptian parties football league and won 1st place.

2. Regional level

FEY is member of AYUFD and currently elected as member of the executive bureau of AYFD, participated in Amman 2015 meeting with participation of IFLRY, FNF, D66 and VVD, Tunisia meeting and GA and Lebanon work shop on Immigration and refugees.

3. International Level

FEY is a member of the Danish Egyptian Political Parties Youth Network, through it 3 visits of FEY have been made to Denmark over the year 2015-2016 to exchange experience and enhance capacity building.

5th parliamentary elections:

The free Egyptians party pushed a number of FEY members as parliamentary elections candidates Ibrhaim Abdelwahab (Alexandria), Mohamed Komi (Cairo) Ahmed Aly (Cairo), Ahmed Aathy (Cairo), Ahmed Mortda Mansour (Dokki –agouza), John Boshra (Menya) Sherif Nady (Menya), Amr abd el Azeem (aswan)

And 4 of them won the election and grab a seat in parliament.

FEY committee was involved in many election campaigns both on managing the campaign or participating as members in the campaign and they were able to achieve a great success in helping the candidates to gain access to the largest number of voters and implementing of programs.

6th FEY annual Ramadan iftar:

The Iftar ceremony of the youth had representatives of all the Egyptian civil parties and representatives of the Ministry of Youth, Sports and civil society organizations, the ceremony's was presented first chairman of the party and its leaders and the ceremony included launching of FEY debate club.
