Social Media

These three visions are the main framework of our communications. For statements such as the one on the Swedish election we used our contact persons in the member organization to draft the statement we used on social media. To make our presence relevant it has been necessary to be on top of agendas world-wide and finding the positive visionary angle of any topic. IFLRY has to be an encouraging idealistic agenda-setter in our advocacy. Lastly it has for long been discussed to create a team that could help IFLRY getting a clearer visual profile – that we have now with the visuals team whose results I will talk about later.





Together with Elin, we made a call for a Visual Team that had the task to redesign IFLRY's visual profile in our communications to make it look more clear and professional. The team was formed in June and since then they have given our visual sides a great lift as maybe have been noticed in the graphics for this General Assembly.

For these past months I have had the lead on another big project has been to develop a 'IFLRY Folder/One-pager' that will be distributed to the membership and potential partners. With inputs from Sven, visual help from Julianne from our Visual team and experience from past ideas from Daniel George, the folder is now



ready to be printed and distributed to our membership (and of this date the 8th of November I am still hopeful to bring them for the General Assembly).

Delivered objectives:

- ✓ Developing professional promotional materials that can be disseminated in its membership as well as been used for approaching external partners and potential donors.
- ✓ Develop a comprehensive 'Communication Strategy 2020' that aligns all communication efforts of the federation on its website, Social Media, newsletter, and other channels.
- ✓ Start a Communications & Campaign Team to use the resources of the membership.

European Youth Forum

As the international voice of young liberal across the world we – the bureau - have the obligation to stand up and advocate for our values. So I have in our European partner, European Youth Forum. For this past year I have been representing IFLRY in the European Working Group that are consulting the European Union's Commission on the development of their new Youth strategy.





On the same week as we are gathering in Barcelona for our General Assembly, European Youth Forum is gathering in Novi Sad in Serbia where they will have their GA. Together with our former Executive Director, Andrea, and our former president, Christian Scharling (who attends as IFLRY's representative), we are coordinating our approach and votes for the General Assembly.

The program managers are currently working on an action plan and in a short while they will also be busy organizing the annual IFLRY participation in the Geneva summit in February 2019.
