We are happy to announce the first event of 2020:

IFLRY Regional Initiative South-East Asia.

The region of South-East Asia and its heterogeneous needs have posed a challenge for IFLRY's in the past.

In the new year of 2020, the Regional Initiative South-East Asia is aiming to face this challenge and to improve our presence in the region.

In the Regional Initiative we will map the obstacles that young people in South-East Asia face and create an overview of their situation, so that we have a solid ground for further activities.

Based on that, we can build grassroots capacity to improve our presence in the region in a sustainable, long-term approach.

This 3-day training which will take place between 9 and 12 January 2020 in Yangon, Myanmar is aimed at participants from Myanmar, Thailand, Taiwan, Indonesia, Hong Kong, and the Philippines. As the project is also a continuation of strengthening IFLRY's presence in Asia—starting with the IFLRY-IUSY Field Trip to India in 2019—we will also invite participants from our newly gained partners in India.

Date & Venue:

Arrival: Participants are expected to arrive at the venue before 18:00 on Friday, 9th of January 2020

Departure: Participants are expected to depart after 14:00 on Sunday, 12th of January 2020

Funding:

An official acceptance and confirmation from IFLRY office is required to start booking the tickets.
