Dear female leaders,

It is our great pleasure to invite you to participate in the Special Female Leadership Program 2020. The program this year will be a hybrid platform of an all-encompassing online stage with participants from Belarus, Lebanon, Jordan and South Africa, as well as very targeted in-person meetings for local leaders on the ground.

As the first event of its kind, we invite you to take part in an online stage alongside females from 4 different countries. In this online stage, we will have joint online meetings on various skills-based topics, such as storytelling, networking or facilitation. These online stages will then lead to in-person challenge meetings where you will come together in your respective countries (each of the time only 5-7 people) and then in a boot-camp format solve leadership challenges with the guidance of an IFLRY facilitator on the ground. The seminars will take place in Minsk, Beirut, Amman, and Cape Town.

COVID-19 MEASURES: Please read carefully

We will do everything in our power to limit the risk of infection during this event. Participants will stay in single rooms and keep the distance as much as possible during the whole training. We will also provide hygiene equipment on the ground. Yet, we encourage participants to bring a sufficient number of face masks and/or face shields for yourself.

You **CAN NOT** participate in the event if you have been in contact with a person who got tested positive on Covid-19 less than 7 days before the event or if you have symptoms of COVID-19. Before the event, you therefore ask you to submit a declaration form stating your acknowledgement of these criteria.

We can not reimburse your costs, if you can not attend for personal reasons or due to changes in regulations from any official side.

Date & Venue:

Online Phase: The online seminars will take place in November, more details will be published soon.

Bootcamp: Afterwards the Participants will join each other in their respective country for the “Female Leadership Challenge” for a full weekend.

Funding:

Meals and accommodation of the participants during the activity will be covered. Travel costs will be reimbursed upon presentation of all tickets and receipts. Participants are required to travel in a reasonable and safe economical manner (Uber app and the like are encouraged).

Language and Format

English is the working language of this study session.

The sessions will be held using **Non-Formal Education** format and methodology. Non-Formal Education is participant-centered, action-oriented and value-based. It is instruction that is not obligatory and structured and is learned outside the context of a formal school. IFLRY has been an ardent advocate of Non-Formal Education and is using it as a leading approach in its events and activities.
